

A5 Talking Photo Album

Reference number: 101

The album has 20 pockets allowing for up to 40 images to be displayed.

The built-in recorder allows you to record separate voice messages on each page.

Audio clips are stored on an SD memory card which can be erased allowing re-recording at any time.



Possible uses for this include:

- Creating your own talking book by drawing pictures and recording the story to accompany each page
- Creating a visual guide to a new experience for children or adults (e.g. starting school)
- Creating a reminiscences book for people living with dementia

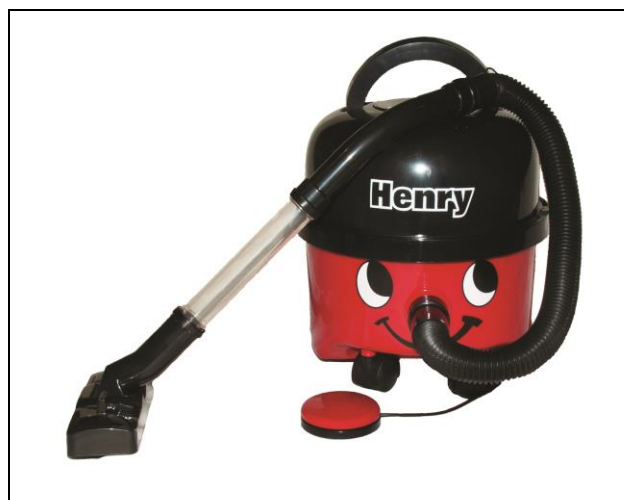
Switch Adapted Toy: Henry the Hoover
