NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on lengths both sides of South Farm Road in Worthing between its junction with Ardsheal Close and Ardsheal Road.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting on lengths both sides of South Farm Road in Worthing between its junction with Ardsheal Close and Ardsheal Road.

A project to review locations used by school crossing patrols has identified South Farm Road in Worthing for improvement works. An informal pedestrian crossing point with lowered kerbs is to be installed on South Farm Road mid-way between its junctions with Ardsheal Close and Ardsheal Road. As part of these works it is proposed to install new lengths of double yellow lines on both sides of South Farm Road to prevent parked cars obstructing pedestrian visibility.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ1404NWS and TQ144SWN show the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

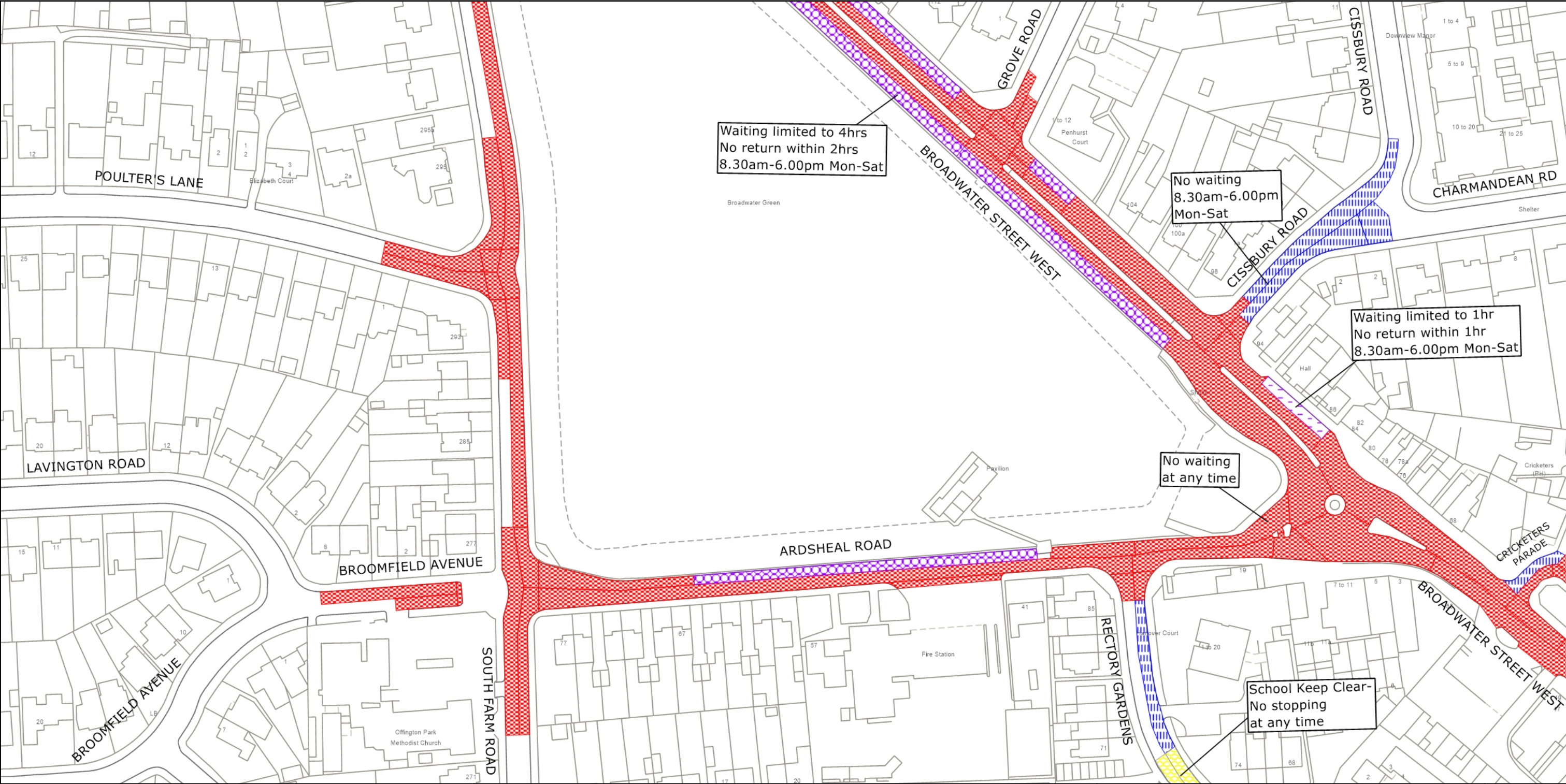

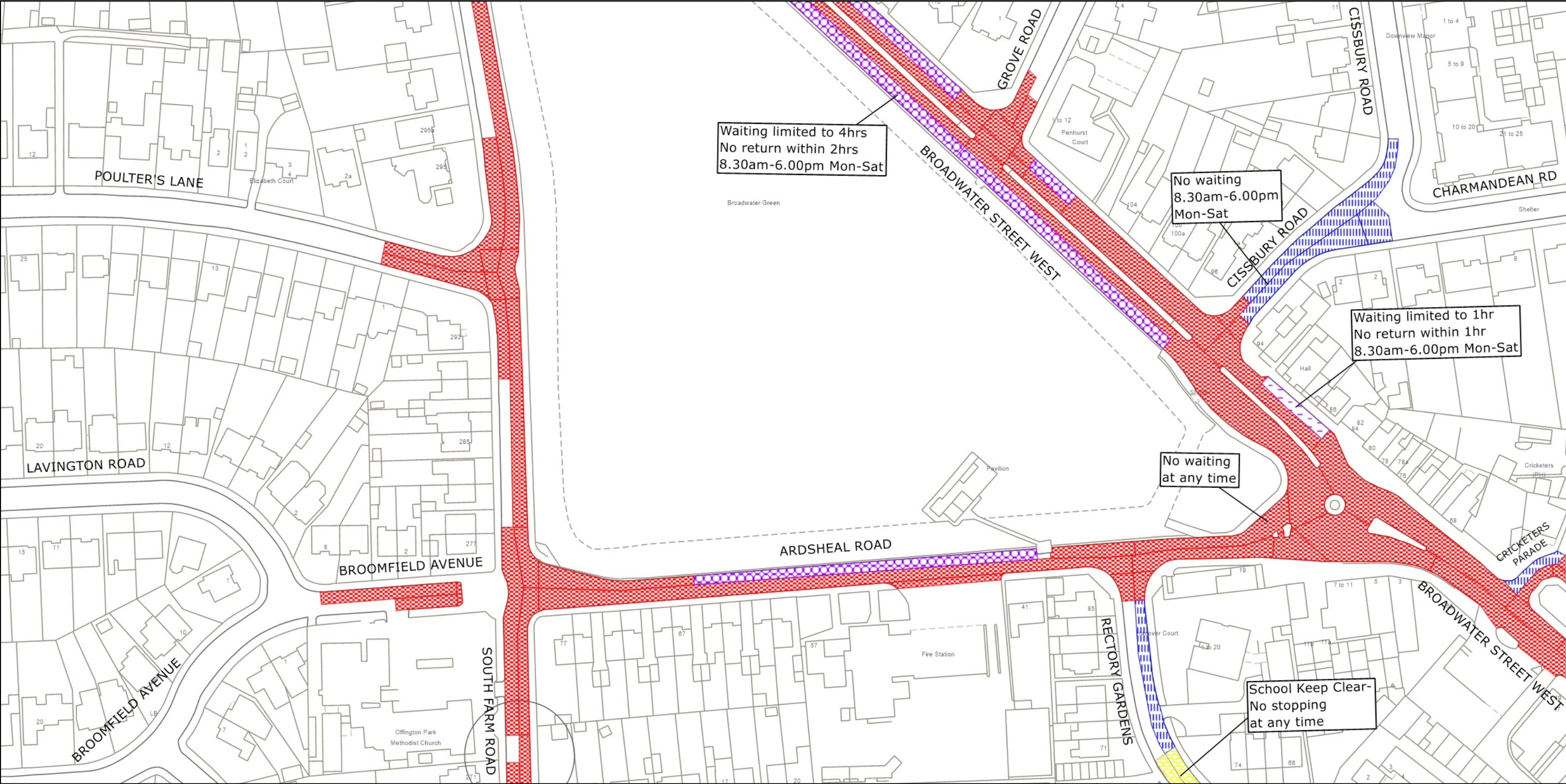
