NOTICE is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which came into force on 30 April 2024, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 30 October 2026 or until the works are completed.


The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to a collapsed flood defence embankment making the path unusable. It is not safe to open the path until repairs have been undertaken.

The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 3200 from its junction with Footpath 3625 at Eatons Bridge (TQ190161), south-eastwards to its junction with footpath 2520_1 (TQ189160).

Unfortunately there are no alternative routes available using the Public Rights of Way network.
