NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to introduce a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on lengths of School Lane and Common View.

Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on lengths of School Lane and Common View.

The roads through Stedham with Iping village are currently subject to a 30mph speed limit. Concerns have been raised locally about the safety of school children in School Lane that has neither footways nor streetlighting. The local community with support from the Parish Council and the school have requested a 20mph speed limit be introduced on School Lane.

The application has been assessed in accordance with the West Sussex Speed Limit Policy. A 20mph speed limit is appropriate in School Lane as the road has a pub as well as the school and there are a number of public rights of way routes in the vicinity so in addition to vehicular traffic there are pedestrians, especially at school drop off and pick up times, and equestrians.

To encourage compliance with the reduced speed limit it is proposed that yellow backed terminal signage will be installed to indicate the 20mph speed limit together with repeater signs being installed at regular intervals along School Lane.

This Order is proposed for facilitating safe passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

Drawing CHI2601 Stedham – School Lane (07.07.2026) proposed 20mph speed limit shows the lengths of roads, which are the subject of the proposed order.

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the X day of X 202* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Stedham with Iping: School Lane, The Street & Adjoining Roads) (20mph & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 202*"
2. The Order in the First Schedule to this Order shall be revoked.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order
5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 and 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

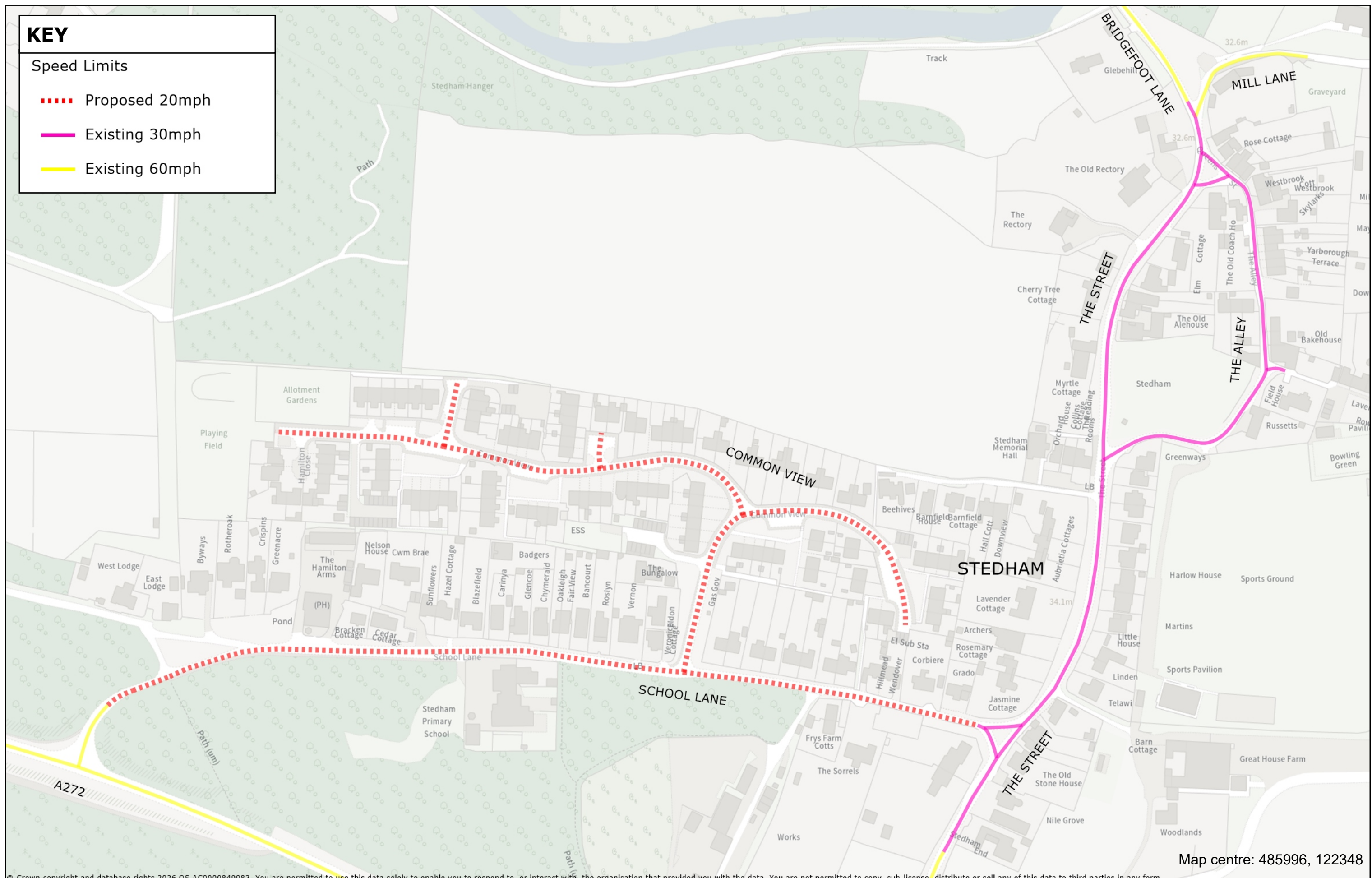
