NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit at the western end of Turners Hill Road in Worth to a point 475m east of its junction with Old Hollow.

The Order also introduces a 40 MPH Speed limit from the eastern end of the 30 MPH speed limit described above, eastwards to the current 30 MPH speed limit at Turners Hill.

In addition to these measures the Order introduces a 30 MPH speed limit on Old Hollow from Turners Hill Road, northwards for 175m, and a 40 MPH speed limit on Wallage Lane, from Turners Hill Road north-eastwards for 60m.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit at the western end of Turners Hill Road in Worth to a point 475m east of its junction with Old Hollow.

The Order also introduces a 40 MPH Speed limit from the eastern end of the 30 MPH speed limit described above, eastwards to the current 30 MPH speed limit at Turners Hill.

In addition to these measures the Order introduces a 30 MPH speed limit on Old Hollow from Turners Hill Road, northwards for 175m, and a 40 MPH speed limit on Wallage Lane, from Turners Hill Road north-eastwards for 60m.

A Route Safety Assessment has been carried out on Turners Hill Road due to the number of collisions and road safety incidents on the road. The review identified that the current 60 MPH speed limit on the route is unsuitable and that lowering it would assist drivers adopt an appropriate speed for the road environment and conditions. The proposed measures have been assessed against the West Sussex County Council Speed Limit Policy which sets speed limits based on safety history, the use of the road by vulnerable road users and current average speeds. This assessment supported reducing the speed limit on the route to 40 MPH, with an extension to the 30 MPH speed limit at the western end of the route.

Short lengths of speed limit are included on Old Hollow and Wallage Lane so signage can be installed at appropriate locations on the approach to their junctions with Turners Hill Road. The Order also consolidates the existing speed limits at the eastern end of Turners Hill Road for housekeeping purposes.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, numbered MDS8016 shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

(30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) AND (SPEED LIMIT CONSOLIDATION)
ORDER 2026

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ***** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Turners Hill and Worth: Turners Hill Road) (30 MPH and 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2026"
2. The Orders Specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 or 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

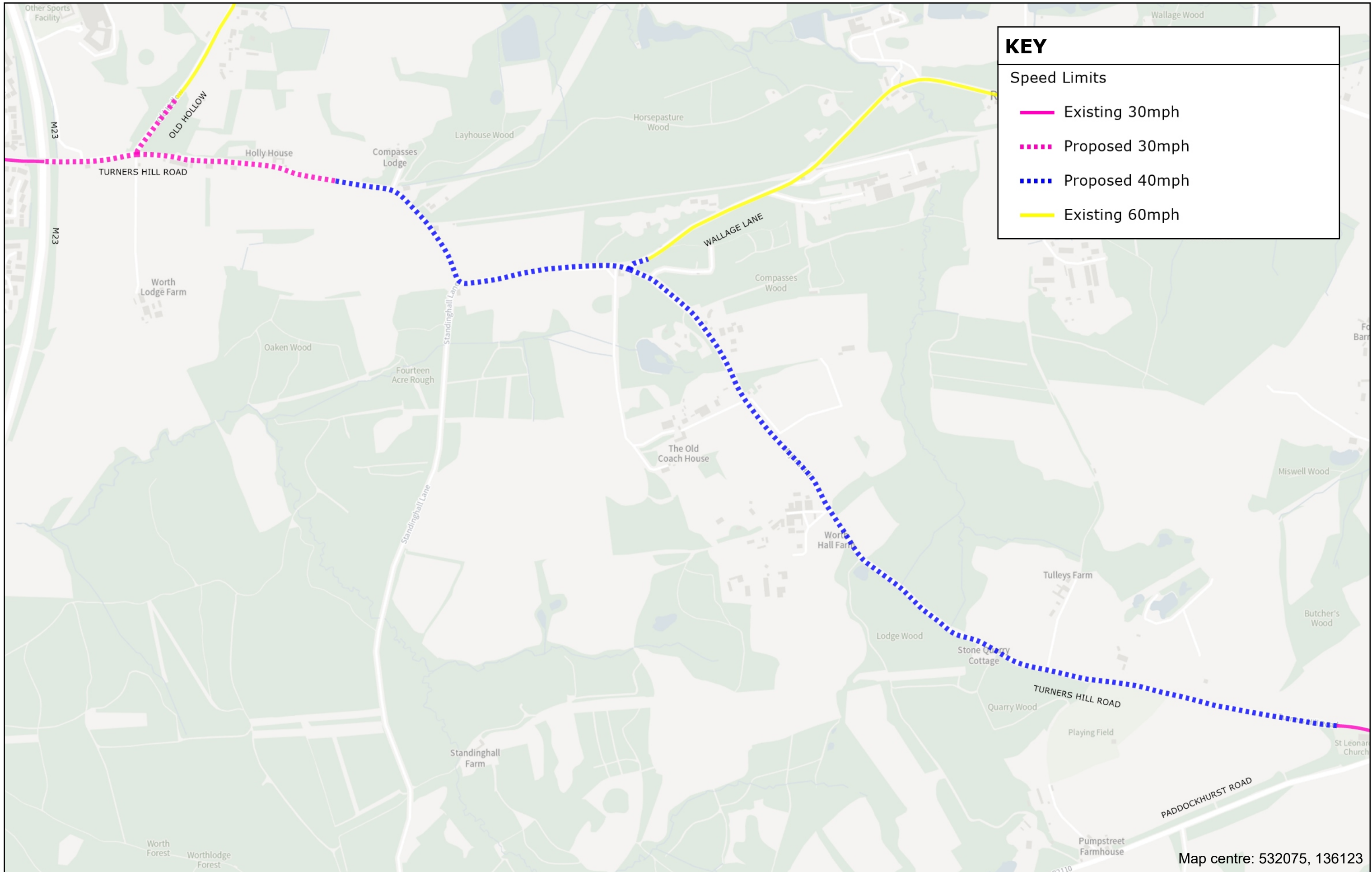
