The above Order made on the 7 October 2025 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 will divert part of public footpath 2475 in the Parish of Thakeham and modify the Definitive Map and Statement for Chanctonbury.

The effect of the order is to **divert part** of footpath 2475 from its junction with the public highway, Crays Lane (grid ref 511331, 117832) which continues northwest for approximately 30 metres before heading southwest and substituting this with a new length of footpath commencing approximately 112 metres south west of its original junction on Crays Lane (grid ref 511284, 117735) and continuing north west for approximately 91 metres to reach the existing length of path as shown between points C and D on the Order plan.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the West Sussex County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
