

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS 2025/26 NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS

Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014
The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 (as amended)

Members of the public are afforded various rights as part of the annual audit process. For the 2025/26 financial statements, including the financial statements of the West Sussex Pension Fund, these rights may only be exercised in the period 15 July 2026 to 25 August 2026. These rights can be summarised as follows:

- (1) Any interested person may inspect and copy the accounting records for the financial year and all related books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents of this body
- (2) An elector for the area of West Sussex County Council may question the auditor about the 2025/26 accounts
- (3) An elector for the area of West Sussex County Council may make an objection on any matter in respect of which the auditor could take action under the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.
