NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the western side of South Farm Road in Worthing, adjacent to Offington Park Methodist Church.

(South Farm Road Amendment) Order 2026

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time on the western side of South Farm Road in Worthing, adjacent to Offington Park Methodist Church.

In 2025 a scheme of footway improvements was installed on South Farm Road at the location used by a local school crossing patrol. To improve visibility at this location existing double yellow lines were extended, while leaving a short gap in the new yellow lines outside Offington Park Methodist Church.

As per standard practice, a Road Safety Audit of the scheme was carried out after implementation. This identified that the parking retained on the western side of South Farm Road was still obstructing sightlines for traffic at the site of the crossing patrol and recommended that the double yellow lines should be extended in the interests of safety.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ1404NWS shows the length of road affected by the proposed order.

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (a) 2 (1) and (2), 4 (2), 45. 46. 49 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ***** 2026 and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council ((Worthing) (Parking Places & Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2007) (South Farm Road Amendment) Order 2026".




