NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to introduce a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 40mph speed limit on lengths of the B2110 Handcross Road east of Howards Nursery, B2110 Leechpond Hill south of the sewage works, B2115 Sandygate Lane west of Trinity Field and B2115 Warninglid Lane south of Handcross Road.

Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to introduce a 40mph speed limit on lengths of the B2110 Handcross Road east of Howards Nursery, B2110 Leechpond Hill south of the sewage works, B2115 Sandygate Lane west of Trinity Field and B2115 Warninglid Lane south of Handcross Road.

The roads in Lower Beeding village centre have a 30mph speed limit but on the approaches to the village the roads are subject to either a 50mph speed limit or are derestricted and subject to the National Speed Limit. The Parish Council applied for a Community Highways Scheme due to concerns about traffic speeds and safety.

It is proposed to introduce 40mph buffer speed limits on the 'B' roads approaching the village from the east west and south. The lower speed limits aim to create a safer environment for all road users including pedestrians walking along these roads.

This Order is proposed so as to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the safe passage of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Drawing HOR8011 Lower Beeding – Handcross Road, Leechpond Hill, Sandygate Lane & Warninglid Lane proposed speed limit (10.07.2025) shows the lengths of roads, which are the subject of the proposed order.

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(1) (a) and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the X Day of x 202* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Lower Beeding: B2110, B2115 & Church Lane) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*"
- 2. This Order shall supersede any previous speed limit Order relating to the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules to this Order
- 3. The Orders in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 5. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 6. Nothing in Paragraphs 4 and 5 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
