

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(SHIPLEY: PUBLIC FOOTPATH No. 3217)**  
**(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which came into force on 4 November 2024, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 4 November 2026 or until the works are completed.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to a broken footbridge. The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 3217 from its northern end at its junction with School Lane (grid reference 514289.1, 121933.5), southwards to its junction with Countryman Lane (grid reference 514217.6, 121362.4), a distance of approximately 604 metres.

Unfortunately there is no alternative routes available using the Public Rights of Way network.


