**(FISHBOURNE: PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 3059)**  
**(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which came into force on 24 March 2022, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 23 September 2026.

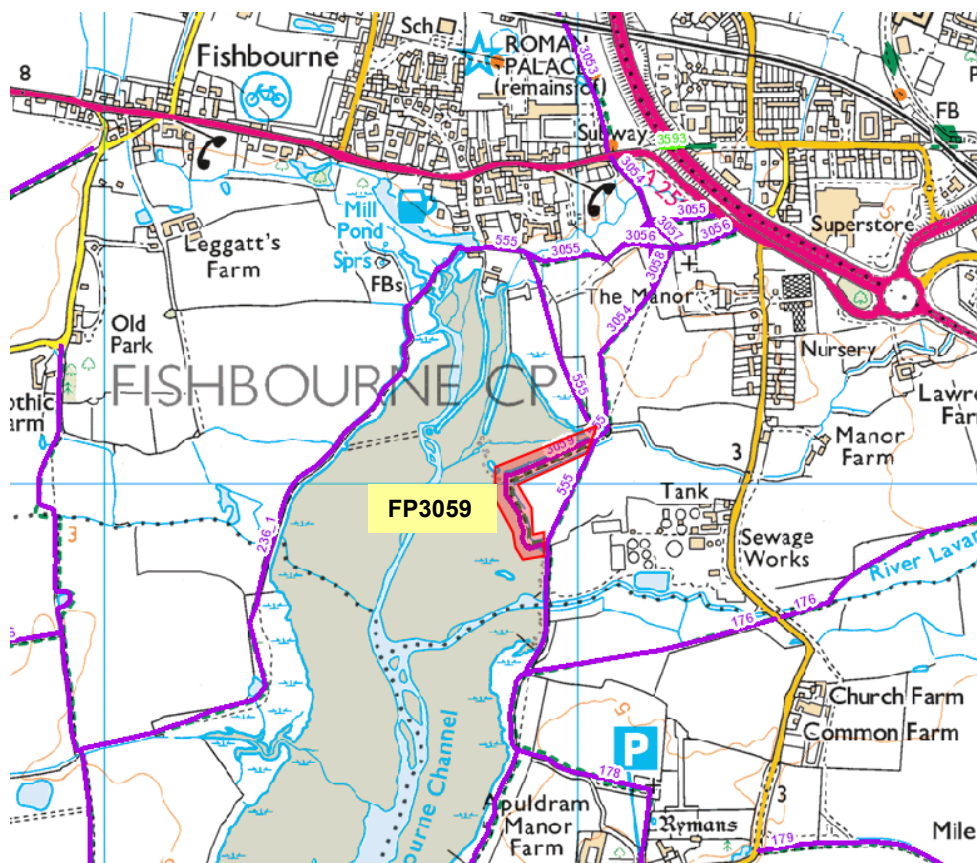
The Order is necessary to protect public safety as a section of the sea wall over which the footpath passes has been washed out by the sea. The sea wall is not repairable and so a planning application is under consideration for a project to realign the coastal margin, to include a new coastal path.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 3059 Fishbourne, from its northern end at its junction with Public Footpath No.555 (SU840041), running south-westwards and then south-eastwards to its other junction with Public Footpath No. 555 (SU839038), a total distance of approximately 425 metres.

Public Footpath No. 555 is a short distance away to use as an alternative to the coastal route.
