NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to install a new zebra crossing at the eastern end of St Lawrence Avenue in Worthing, approximately mid-way between its junction with South Farm Road and the northern entrance to Worthing High School.

NOTICE is also hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to amend the parking restrictions at the eastern end of St Lawrence Avenue to accommodate the new pedestrian crossing described above. The effect of these changes will be to remove existing single yellow line restrictions on both sides of the road and an existing parking bay (waiting limited to 1 hr 8.30am to 6pm) on the north side of St Lawrence Avenue, replacing them with a restriction prohibiting waiting at any time.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex proposes to install a new zebra crossing at the eastern end of St Lawrence Avenue in Worthing, approximately mid-way between its junction with South Farm Road and the northern entrance to Worthing High School.

The new crossing is proposed to improve safety for pedestrians, particularly children walking to the nearby high school.

The zebra crossing will not be installed with traffic signals and will feature illuminated poles and white zig-zag road markings in accordance with the standard layout of a crossing of this type.

It is also proposed to remove existing single yellow line restrictions and an existing parking bay (waiting limited to 1 hr 8.30am to 6pm) on the north side of St Lawrence Avenue, replacing them with a restriction prohibiting waiting at any time.

The above changes to the parking restrictions on St Lawrence Avenue are necessary to accommodate the white zig-zag line markings of the new crossing. These markings are standard at controlled crossings and maintain safety by preventing vehicles parking near the crossing and obstructing visibility.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road

The attached drawing, numbered TQ1403NWN shows the parking restrictions proposed by the Order.





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
