**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which came into force on 8 March 2025, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport will now continue in force until 8 September 2026 or until the footpath is safe to reopen.


The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to a section of sea wall having been washed out by coastal erosion undermining the footpath.

The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along the length of Public Footpath No. 230 from its northern end at its junction with the A259 Main Road (SU804052), southwards to its junction with Public Footpath No. 2824 (SU804045), a distance of approximately 850 metres.
