#### <u>West Sussex County Council</u> (Worthing: Marine Parade (A259) And Montague Place) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2025 <u>And</u> West Sussex County Council ((Worthing) (Parking Places & Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2007) (Montague Place and Marine Parade Amendment) <u>Order 2025</u> <u>And</u> Worthing: Marine Place (A259) Proposed Pedestrian Crossing amendment and New Traffic Calming Feature

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be as follows:

The first Order extends the current 20 MPH speed limit on Marine Parade (A259) in Worthing to a point 35m west of its junction with Montague Place and includes Montague Place in the 20 MPH speed limit. The Order also prohibits driving (except for access to Beaulieu Court) on Montague Place from its junction with Marine Parade (A259) northwards to the entrance to Beaulieu Court.

The second Order removes the current loading bays on Montague Place in Worthing and replaces them with a restriction prohibiting waiting, loading and unloading at any time. The Order also installs new loading bays for any vehicle at any time on the northern side of Marine Parade (A259) either side of its junction with Montague Place. It also amends lengths of restriction prohibiting waiting, loading and unloading at any time on Marine Parade (A259) at its junction with Montague Place to accommodate alterations to a pedestrian crossing described below.

NOTICE is also hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to move the existing pedestrian crossing located on Marine Parade (A259) immediately west of its junction with Montague Place to a new location immediately east of its junction with Montague Place. The re-located pedestrian crossing would be installed upon a new raised traffic calming feature located on Marine Parade (A259) at its junction with Montague Place. This raised feature would be approximately 40m in length, not exceeding 65mm in height and constructed in black McAdam.

## Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic Regulation Orders in Worthing as follows:

The first Order extends the current 20 MPH speed limit on Marine Parade (A259) in Worthing to a point 35m west of its junction with Montague Place and includes Montague Place in the 20 MPH speed limit. The Order also prohibits driving (except for access to Beaulieu Court) on Montague Place from its junction with Marine Parade (A259) northwards to the entrance to Beaulieu Court.

The second Order removes the current loading bays on Montague Place in Worthing and replaces them with a restriction prohibiting waiting, loading and unloading at any time. The Order also installs new loading bays for any vehicle at any time on the northern side of Marine Parade (A259) either side of its junction with Montague Place. It also amends lengths of restriction prohibiting waiting, loading and unloading at any time on Marine Parade (A259), at its junction with Montague Place to accommodate alterations to a pedestrian crossing described below.

West Sussex County Council also proposes to move the existing pedestrian crossing located on Marine Parade (A259) immediately west of its junction with Montague Place to a new location immediately east of its junction with Montague Place. The re-located pedestrian crossing would be installed upon a new raised traffic calming feature located on Marine Parade (A259) at its junction with Montague Place. This raised feature would be approximately 40m in length and not exceeding 65mm in height and constructed in black McAdam.

The above measures are proposed as part of public realm improvement scheme that will install new planting and seating in Montague Place and improve pedestrian connectivity between Montague Place and Worthing Seafront.

To accommodate the new features on Montague Place, current loading bays at the southern end of the road will be relocated to new laybys on the northern side of Marine Parade (A259). Vehicular access to Montague Place will be prohibited except for vehicles using the access to Beaulieu Court.

To improve access between the new public space and Worthing seafront the existing pedestrian crossing on Marine Parade west of its junction with Montague Place is being moved to a new location east of the junction. The new location of the crossing will allow a new ramped access to be installed between Marine Parade and the seafront promenade, replacing the current steps, narrow access ramp and narrow footway at the location of the current crossing.

The crossing is to be installed on a new traffic calming feature, which along with widened footways and an extended 20 MPH speed limit, will reduce traffic speeds, improving pedestrian safety.

The new restrictions are therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to improve the amenities of the area through which the affected roads run.

The attached drawing, titled Montague Place General Arrangement shows the extended speed limit, relocated crossing and traffic calming feature. Drawing number TQ1402SEN shows the amendments to parking restrictions.

#### <u>WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (WORTHING: MARINE PARADE (A259) AND MONTAGUE PLACE) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the \*\*\*\*\* day of \*\*\*\*\*\* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Worthing: Marine Parade (A259) and Montague Place) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2025"
- 2. The Parts of Orders Specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

#### **Speed Limit Provisions**

- 3. The lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order shall not be restricted roads for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 or 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –

(a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and

(b) the vehicle is being driven-

(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or

(ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

#### **Prohibition of Driving Provisions**

- 6. Save as provided by Article 7, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lenth of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 7. Nothing in Article 6 shall apply to a vehicle being used by the Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in the event of an emergency.
- 8. Save as provided by Article 9, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specicified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
- 9. Nothing in Article 8 shall apply to:
  - a) to a vehicle being used by the Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in the event of an emergency; or
  - b) A vehicle belonging to a resident of, or visitor to Beaulieu Court proceeding only to gain access to the parking garage of that property


