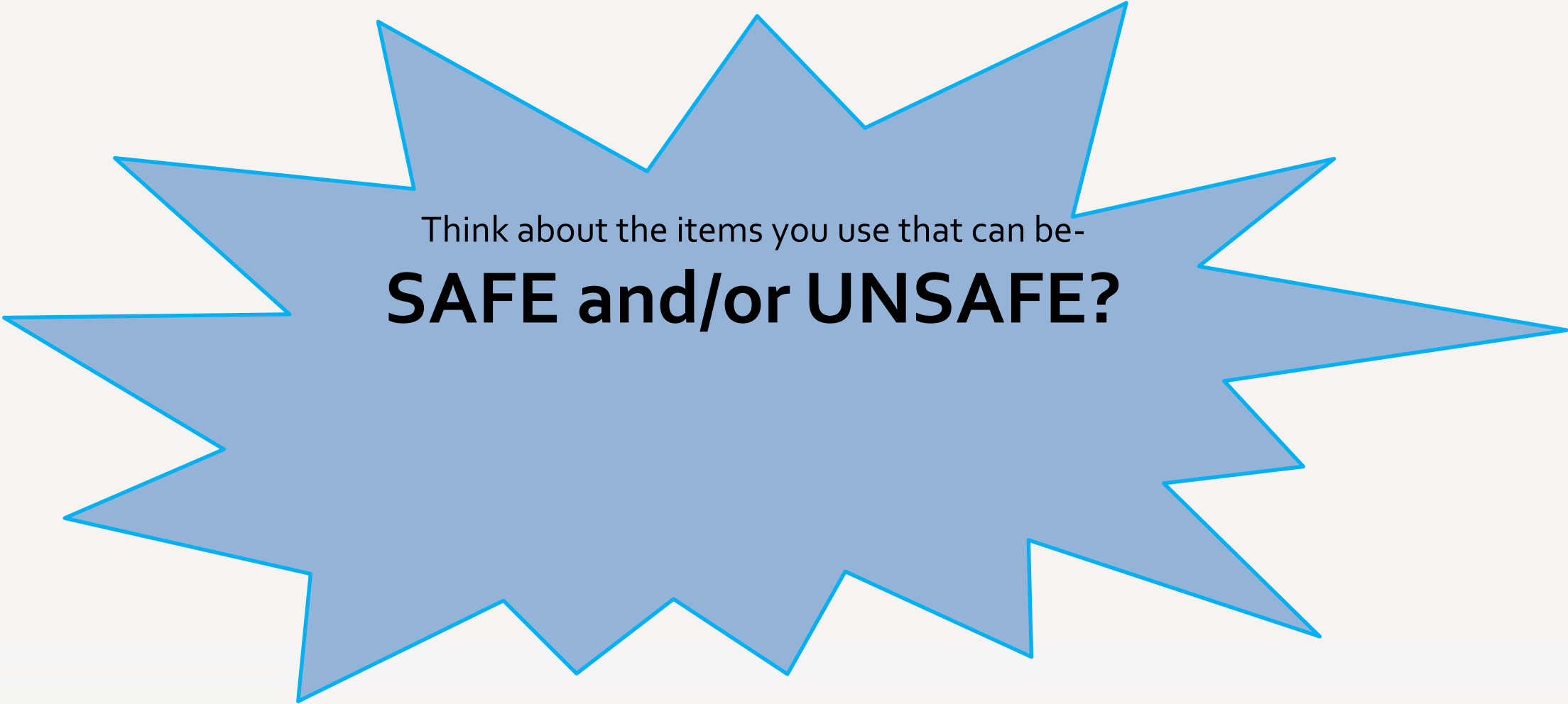

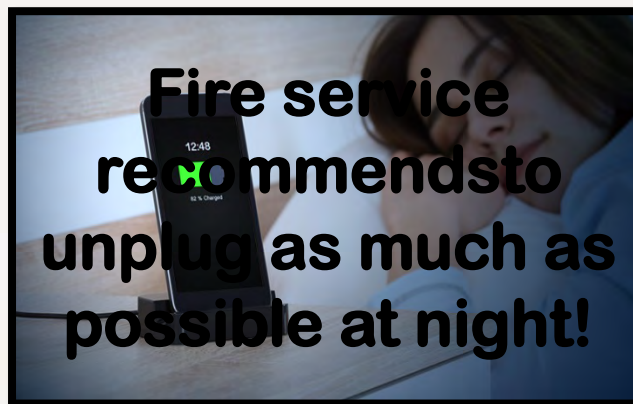

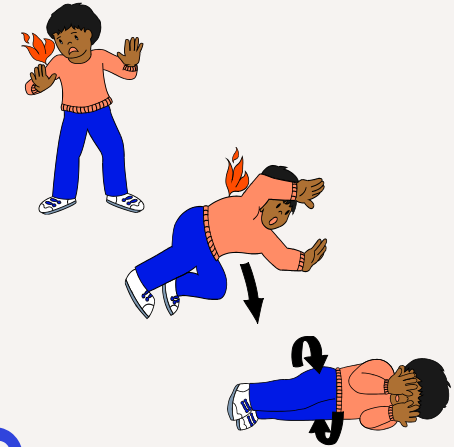
**The best way to stop a fire is to prevent it
happening in the first place.**



Heat



Oxygen



Fuel



**Preventing fire is the best
way to keep safe!**

Make sure your smoke alarm is tested weekly!



What would you do if your alarm sounds whilst you are sleeping?



Shout
to make sure everyone is awake!



Feel the door with the back
of the hand if door closed



Open the door –
door handle cold



Group together with
other people in the home



Go to exit if safe to
do so



Unlock door if
locked.

Is your door locked
at night, where are
the keys?



Exit to a safe place,
don't go back in for
anything!



Call **999**,
Ask for the Fire service
Tell them the address
and type of emergency!

ARSON and
HOAX?

Arson is the act of deliberately setting fire to an object. This could be a building, vehicle, bin or any other object.

A Hoax call is a false or prank to the emergency services

ARSON AND MAKING A HOAX CALL IS A CRIMINAL
OFFENCE

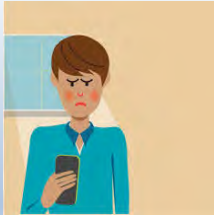

"One of one of the classrooms is on fire at the school'. Everyone has evacuated!"

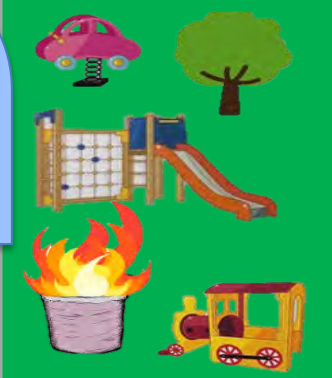

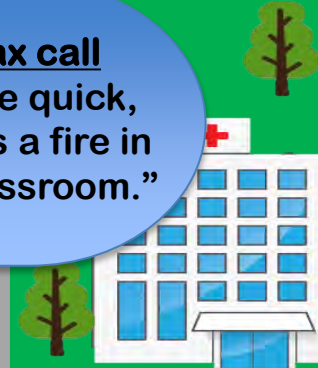

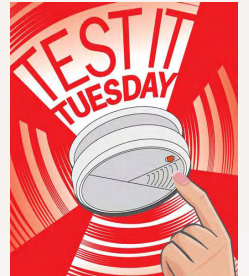
