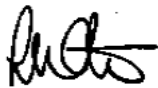
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

In pursuance of its powers and duties under the above-mentioned Act and Regulations, the West Sussex County Council has investigated the matters stated in the application numbered DMMO 5/20 made by the British Horse Society for an order modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for Chichester.

The West Sussex County Council hereby gives notice that under delegated authority on the 14th September 2026 it has decided not to make an order to amend the Definitive Map and Statement to record a Byway Open to All Traffic from Grevatts Lane West between points A and B on the Application Plan in the Parish of Yapton CP

NOTES

1. Where the authority decides not to make an order, the applicant may, at any time within 28 days after service on him of notice of the decision, serve notice of appeal against that decision on the Secretary of State and the authority.
2. An appeal must be made in writing, giving the grounds for the appeal and be accompanied by copies of the application, the map showing the path or way concerned, the supporting documentation and the authorities' decision. The appeal should be made to:

3. A copy of the notice of the appeal, but without accompaniments, must also be served on the West Sussex County Council, Legal Services, County Hall, West Street, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ.
4. If on considering the appeal the Secretary of State considers that an order should be made, he will direct the County Council to make an order accordingly
