
Introduction

 Public health information on – being healthy, sexual health, mental health advice, etc.



Did you know about the disability register? If you didn't, how can we let more people know about it?






- Not all members knew about the disability register.

Discussion


Board members were asked:

 People said that information about the menopause would be helpful.
