NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to introduce a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce:-

- (i) a 20mph speed limit on the length of the A29 through Coldwaltham village and on the roads in Coldwaltham village; and
- (ii) a 30mph speed limit on the length of the A29 between Bury Gate and Watersfield; and
- (iii) a 40mph speed limit on the length of the A29 between Coldwaltham and Pulborough.

Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order, the effect of which will be to introduce:-

- (i) a 20mph speed limit on the length of the A29 through Coldwaltham village and on the roads in Coldwaltham village; and
- (ii) a 30mph speed limit on the length of the A29 south of Watersfield to the B2138; and
- (iii) a 40mph speed limit on the length of the A29 between Coldwaltham and Pulborough.

Coldwaltham Parish Council submitted a community highway scheme application for a speed limit reduction along the A29 from Bury Gate to Pulborough. There is currently a 30mph speed limit on the A29 between Watersfield and Coldwaltham and on the roads in Coldwaltham village with the remaining length of the A29 being unrestricted

The route has been assessed in accordance with the WSCC Speed Limit Policy. The result of the assessment is reduced speed limits be introduced along the route.

A 40mph speed limit is considered appropriate on the section of the A29 between Coldwaltham and Pulborough. This section of the A29 is within the South Downs National Park and it is proposed that the new 40mph speed limit will be implemented with standard terminal signs supported by roundels at the entry points and 40mph repeater signs along the route.

A 30mph speed limit is proposed on the A29 from the B2138 Bury Gate to Watersfield village.

A 20mph speed limit is proposed on the A29 through Coldwaltham and on the roads in Coldwaltham village. The 20mph speed limit in Coldwaltham will be supported by two Vehicle Activated Signs.

The aim of the scheme is to reduce speeds along the A29, address collisions and improve road safety for all users.

This Order is proposed so as to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the safe passage of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Drawing HOR8015 Coldwaltham A29 London Road Proposed Speed Limits (11.03.2026) shows the lengths of roads, which are the subject of the proposed Order.

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the *day of * 202* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Coldwaltham, Bury & Fittleworth: A29 & Adjoining Roads) (20mph, 30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) (& Consolidation) Order 202*"
2. The Orders in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
5. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
6. Nothing in Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

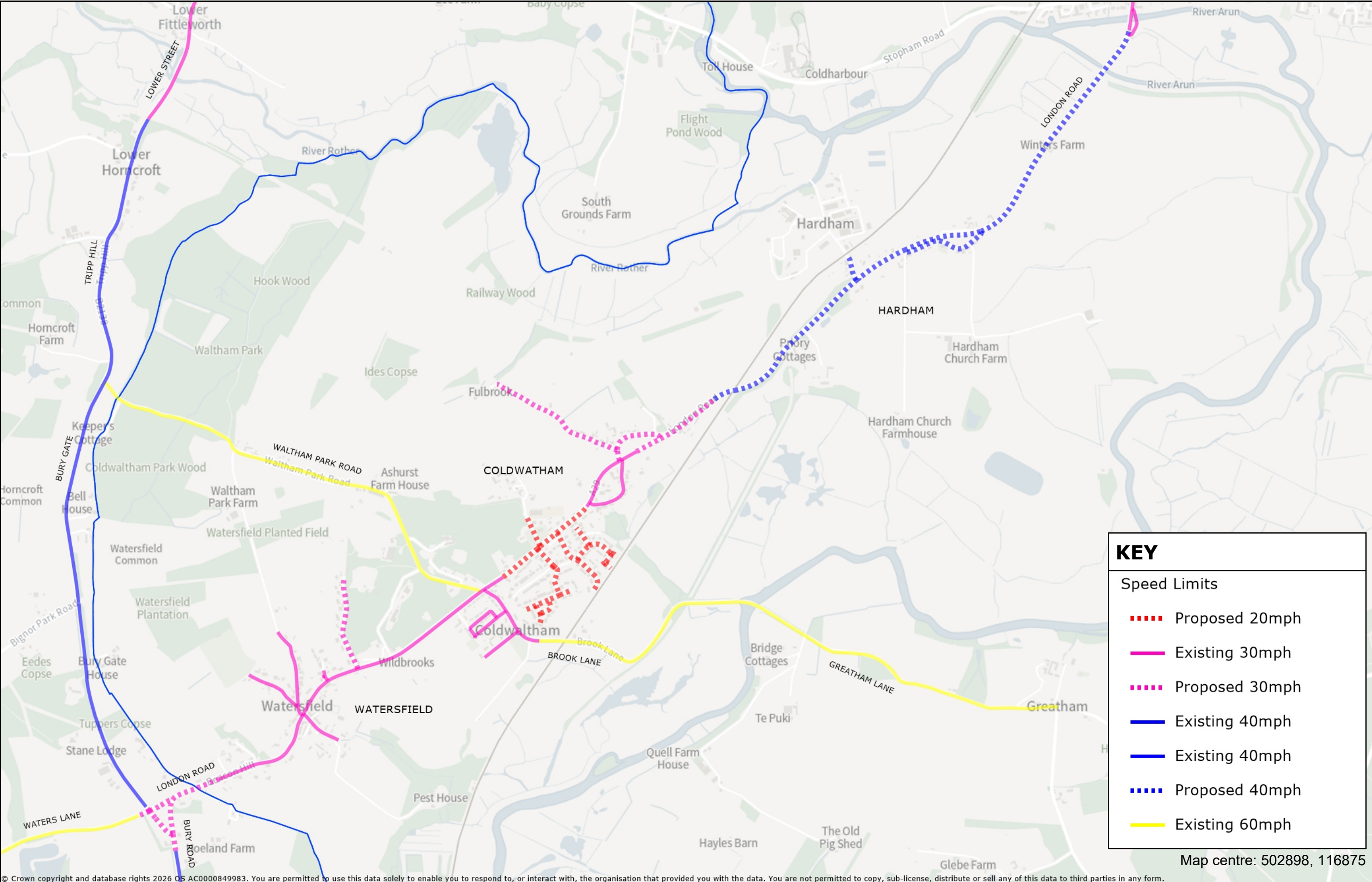
