#### **Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order**

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph on Briton Drive, Cissa Crescent, Mallow Close, Saxon End, Sea Lavender Way and Sloe Lane

Planning permission has been granted for a development of upto 100 dwellings with associated access, landscaping and public open space on land south of Clappers Lane, Earnley. Clappers Lane is subject to a 30mph speed limit. The access road from Clappers Lane into the development will be known as Briton Drive and this will provide access to the other roads on the development site. All the roads are being designed to a 20mph design standard with sections of carriageway block paving.

This Order is proposed so as to reduce danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the safe passage of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Drawing CHI9008 Earnley – Clappers Lane Proposed 20mph Speed Limit (04.06.2025) shows the lengths of roads, which are the subject of the proposed order.

# WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (EARNLEY: BRITON DRIVE & ADJOINING ROADS) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 (2), 83 (2) and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the X day of X 202\* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Earnley: Briton Drive & Adjoining roads) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202\*"
- 2. The length of restricted roads in the First Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Paragraph 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
  - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
  - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
    - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
    - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
