#### **Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order**

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to extend the 30mph speed limit on the A259 Main Road Bosham east of Walton Lane eastwards for a distance of 370metres.

As part of the Tapestry Walk development on land north of the A259 Bosham it is proposed to extend the existing 30mph speed limit on the A259 east of Walton Lane eastwards for 370metres. The additional length of 30mph speed limit will ensure the necessary visibility requirements are achieved at the new development accesses.

This Order is proposed so as to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the safe passage of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

# WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (BOSHAM & FISHBOURNE: A259 MAIN ROAD) (30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the x day of x and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Bosham & Fishbourne: A259 Main Road) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202\*"
- 2. The Order in the First Schedule to this Order shall be revoked.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 and 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
  - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
  - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
    - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
    - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
