**DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2026**


The above Order made on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2026 if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by the addition of a footpath commencing where footpath 2563/1 intersects Springlands Lane, (grid reference 520877, 115426) heading in a south easterly direction along Springlands Lane past Springlands Barn for a distance of approximately 80 metres until reaching footpath 2566\_1 along Windmill Lane (grid reference, 520948,115395) with a minimum width of 2.3 metres.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be seen free of charge, by prior appointment, at the office of the Legal Services, County Hall, Chichester, PO19, 1RQ. A copy of the Order and Map may be purchased for £5.00 from Legal Services.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Director of Law and Assurance County Hall, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ or [legal.services@westsussex.gov.uk](mailto:legal.services@westsussex.gov.uk) (quote ref CC803.17065) not later than **3<sup>rd</sup> April 2026**. Applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Any representations or objections to the Order will be kept on a file that is open to the public.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, and if any so made are withdrawn, the West Sussex County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn, will be sent with it. (Objections will be held on a public file and while personal details will be omitted on request, they will become publicly available if and when the Order is sent to the Secretary of State).
