NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce 20 MPH speed limits on the following roads in the parishes of Warningcamp, Lyminster & Crossbush and Poling:

Burpham Road - from 170m south of Warningcamp Lane to 500m northwards for 670m. Blakehurst Lane, Clay Lane, Crossbush Lane, Wharf Lane throughout their entire lengths.

The Order also introduces 40 MPH speed limits on Burpham Road from its junction with the A27 to 170m south of Warningcamp Lane, and from 500m north of Warningcamp Lane to 160m south of its junction with The Splash.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce new 20 MPH speed limits on roads in the parishes of Warningcamp, Burpham, Lyminster & Crossbush and Poling as follows:

Burpham Road - from 170m south of Warningcamp Lane to 500m northwards for 670m. Blakehurst Lane, Clay Lane, Crossbush Lane, Wharf Lane throughout their entire lengths.

The Order also introduces 40 MPH speed limits on Burpham Road from its junction with the A27 to 170m south of Warningcamp Lane, and from 500m north of Warningcamp Lane to 160m south of its junction with The Splash.

Warningcamp Parish Council has submitted an application for a review of speed limits on roads in the vicinity of Warningcamp. The affected roads are mostly very narrow singletrack rural lanes subject to the national (60 MPH) speed limit and are frequently used by walkers, cyclists and equestrians. The applicant believes existing speed limits are unsuitable for the nature of the roads and may encourage sat-nav systems to inappropriately redirect traffic along them when the A27 is congested.

The application has been assessed against the West Sussex County Council speed limit, which considers factors such as the nature of the road, its use by vulnerable road users, existing traffic speeds and safety history. The proposed speed limits are considered to be the most suitable for the affected roads as assessed under the policy.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawing, titled Warningcamp Community Highway Scheme shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

ORDER 2025

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ***** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Warningcamp, Lyminster & Crossbush and Poling) (Various Roads: 20 MPH and 40 MH Speed Limits) Order 2025"
2. The parts of Orders specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 or 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when –
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
