Thinking of becoming a childminder

This online event is for West Sussex residents only, who would like to find out more about a career in childminding. Childminding offers the opportunity to work with children from birth up. As a childminder, you will create opportunities for children to learn and develop. Practically, childminding offers you a flexible timetable, working in your own home or a local venue with other childminders, perhaps whilst also looking after your own children, as well as the challenge of running your own business. Join us to explore key considerations and next steps.

By attending this webinar, you will;

- explore what being a registered childminder involves, including the impact this can have on family life, costs involved in setting up and other considerations
- know the requirements for registering with Ofsted/Childminder Agency
- know the process for registering on the Early Years and/or Childcare register
- know the key legislative requirements for starting a home childcare business, including registration with His Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC) and the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO), insurance requirements, and establishing if consent is required from other parties
- be able to explain the pre-registration visit process
- have knowledge of any next steps or support processes that WSCC offers for new childminders.

Building your childminding business: Part 2 Provision
