The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to the existing bridge having fallen into disrepair and needing to be replaced.


The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No 1128 from its western end at its junction with Public Footpath Nol. 1129 (SU863232), running in an easterly direction to its junction with Brambling Lane (SU868232), a distance of approximately 530 metres.

Unfortunately, there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network.
