NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to amend the speed limits on the B2139 as it passes through Amberley and Houghton as follows:

The extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit to the west of Houghton westwards by 50m from its current terminal point and to introduce a 40 MPH speed limit from the terminal point of the revised 30 MPH speed limit, westwards for 405m; and

To extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit north of Amberley, northwards to a point 95m north of the access road to Amberley Castle.

West Sussex County Council (Amberley and Houghton: B2139) (30 MPH and 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2025

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will amend the speed limits on the B2139 as it passes through Amberley and Houghton as follows:

The extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit to the west of Houghton westwards by 50m from its current terminal point and to introduce a 40 MPH speed limit from the terminal point of the revised 30 MPH speed limit, westwards for 405m; and

To extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit north of Amberley, northwards to a point 95m north of the access road to Amberley Castle.

The B2139 carries high volumes of through traffic and passes through the historic villages of Amberley, which receives high numbers of visitors. To improve pedestrian access in Amberley, a programme of footway improvements has been approved, and as part of this project the opportunity has been taken to review local speed limits.

The proposal to extend the 30 MPH speed limit north of Amberley is intended to improve pedestrian safety at a point where the popular South Downs Way bridleway crosses the road. At Houghton the short extension of the 30 MPH speed limit will allow signage to be relocated to a more appropriate location and improve safety at a private access located on a bend in the road. The 40 MPH speed limit maintains safe traffic speeds on the northern approach to the 30 MPH speed limit.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached drawing, numbered ARN8017 shows the lengths of road affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (AMBERLEY AND HOUGHTON: B2139) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Amberley and Houghton: B2139) (30 MPH and 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2025"
- 2. The Parts of Orders Specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 or 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
