**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (CHANCTONBURY NO. 3: HENFIELD AND
WOODMANCOTE (UPGRADE OF FOOTPATH 2540 TO A BRIDLEWAY AND ADDITION OF
A BRIDLEWAY)) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2025**

The above Order made on 30th December 2025 if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by upgrading to a bridleway a section of footpath 2540 from its commencement on Furners Lane (grid reference 521739, 116150), with a minimum width of 4 metres, to where the path leaves Furners Lane (grid reference 523481,116043) and the addition of a bridleway commencing at the eastern end of the upgraded bridleway (grid reference 523481,116043) north of Furners Lane and proceeding in an easterly direction for 460 metres to Blackstone Lane (grid reference 523934, 116004) with a minimum width of 5 metres.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be seen free of charge, by prior appointment, at the office of the Legal Services, County Hall, Chichester, PO19, 1RQ. A copy of the Order and Map may be purchased for £5.00 from Legal Services.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Director of Law, Assurance & Insight County Hall, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ or legal.services@westsussex.gov.uk (quote ref CC803.15670) not later than **26th February 2026**. Applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Any representations or objections to the Order will be kept on a file that is open to the public.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, and if any so made are withdrawn, the West Sussex County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn, will be sent with it. (Objections will be held on a public file and while personal details will be omitted on request, they will become publicly available if and when the Order is sent to the Secretary of State).
