NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of Lethaby Road in Bersted From its junction with Crimsham Road southwards for 75m.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce double yellow lines on both sides of Lethaby Road in Bersted From its junction with Crimsham Road southwards for 75m.

The new restrictions are proposed following a community TRO application submitted by residents near the affected length of Lethaby Road. It is reported that vehicles parking on or near the traffic calming feature south of Crimsham Road obstruct visibility for pedestrians using the footpath that crosses Lethaby Road at this point and cause congestion for traffic passing along the road.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to facilitate the passage of traffic.

The attached drawing, numbered SU201SWN shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.
